Harvest

The harvest commenced in the first week of September with the Syrah, followed by the Merlot a week later. By mid-September, the Grenache reached optimal ripeness, and soon after, the Cabernet Sauvignon was harvested. The Carignan, known for its resilience, required patience and was picked at the end of the month. This meticulous selection ensures the perfect expression of Priorat's diverse terroir.

Vinification

Each variety is vinified separately to preserve its distinctive qualities. The process takes place in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks, with a pre-fermentation cold maceration that enhances aromatic expression and the extraction of color and texture. During fermentation, gentle pump-overs and manual cap submersions are carried out to delicately integrate the components of the must. Once fermentation is complete, the wine is transferred to barrels by gravity, maintaining the purity and balance of the final wine.

Aging

The wine matures for 12 months in 300-liter French oak barrels, where it evolves in complexity and depth. It is bottled without excessive filtration or intervention, preserving its authenticity. Following bottling, the wine rests in our cellar under ideal conditions, ensuring full integration and refinement before its release.

Tasting Notes

This wine embodies the soul of Priorat, showcasing its distinctive terroir and the interplay of its grape varieties. Predominantly composed of Grenache and Carignan, it delivers fruit-forward intensity, structure, and character. Introduced in the 1980s, the complementary presence of Cabernet Sauvignon adds layers of persistence, depth, and a lingering finish. The 12-month aging in oak refines the tannins and imparts a delicate touch of spice. Expect a harmonious balance of ripe red and black fruit, mineral undertones, and subtle balsamic notes, leading to an elegant and enduring finish.

A wine of remarkable personality and complexity, crafted for discerning enthusiasts of Priorat's exceptional winemaking heritage.
